

Sixth Form Dress Code

As a member of Sponne Sixth Form you are not expected to wear a school uniform. However, you are a role model to the younger years and are expected to dress in a way that is smart and appropriate to the school environment.

Dress Code:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Trousers (tailored/chinos) ● Black jeans (not faded or ripped) ● Collared shirt/plain polo shirt ● Shoes/boots (low to medium heel) ● Jumper/cardigan (in winter months) ● School hoodie (outerwear only) ● Waistcoat (optional) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Skirt/dress (no more than 10cm above the knee) ● Blouse/top/shirt ● Jumper/cardigan (in winter months) ● Jacket (optional) ● Tie (optional) ● Suit (optional)
Footwear:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Shoes need to be plain leather/leather type, suede/suede type formal shoes or boots. Kickers or Doc Martin shoes/ankle boots are permitted. ● They cannot be trainer style (e.g. Vans, Converse etc) even if leather. Canvas shoes are not permitted. ● Trainers, fabric walking boots, Ugg boots, baseball boots, sandals or flip flops are not permitted 	
General Guidelines:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No form of denim clothing is to be worn other than smart black jeans ● No leather clothing apart from footwear ● No shorts/skorts ● No tracksuits, hoodies or T-Shirts ● No beachwear ● No hats or sunglasses ● No leggings to be worn not even with a long t-shirt or top ● No baggy or casual sweatshirts 	
<p>Remember:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Tops with slogans or conspicuous logos are not permitted (eg football/rugby shirts) ● Excessively tight or revealing tops are unacceptable ● Shoestring or narrow strapped tops or dresses are unacceptable ● Underwear should not be on show ● Outdoor jackets or fleeces should not be worn in lessons ● Hairstyles and hair colour should be in keeping with the office dress ethos. Hair should not be dyed excessively bright colours ● Excessive jewellery should not be worn ● Facial piercings should be subtle and not excessive 	
General Information:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Sixth Form School Lanyards: Every student is provided on the first day of term with a school lanyard and identification badge these MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES. Replacements will incur a cost of £5.00 ● The Dress Code will be monitored and sanctions will be put in place if a student persistently fails to meet the conditions of the Dress Code. In extreme cases students will be sent home to change if they are dressed inappropriately for the school environment 	

SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE - CONSEQUENCES AND SANCTIONS	
Verbal Warning	Students report to Miss Elliott in Sixth Form Study Area to receive a dress code pass and discuss a date for the issue to be rectified (maximum 5 days)
C1	A C1 sanction will be issued if a student has not met the review date deadline set at the first verbal warning stage
C2	C2 – if the issue is still unresolved by agreed date set in C1, contact home will be made
