



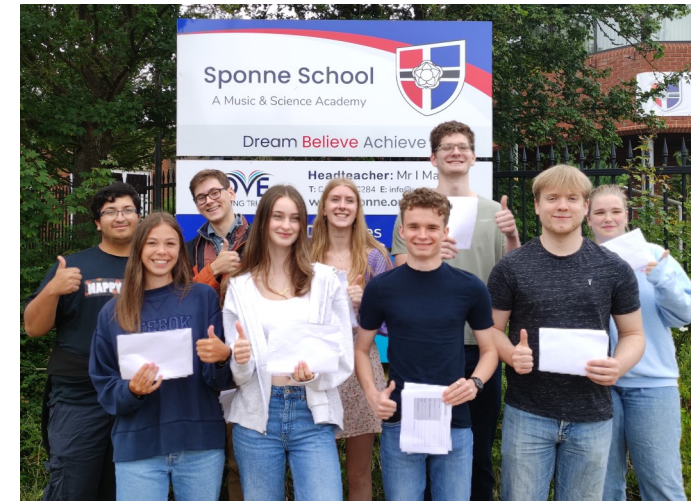
## Key Stage 4 (GCSE/Level 2 qualification) Results 2023
