UCAS and personal statements

We hope you are well. Just a reminder for those students that are applying for university via UCAS.

The UCAS equal consideration deadline is 6pm on January 25th, 2023; however we would like as many applications to be sent off before the Christmas break as possible, as many students are now in a position of being able to submit.

In order for this to happen, students need to have completed their UCAS application online, which includes their personal statement. The personal statement needs to be seen by relevant subject teachers, the form tutor and then by a member of the Sixth Form Team before students can add it to UCAS.

Even though we dedicated the whole of the first term of tutor time to computer rooms in order to complete these, we do appreciate that some students were not/are not aware of what they want to do next year yet, so this will have impacted them not having completed it yet. We have had a variety of assemblies again recently regarding studying in the four home nations and abroad, plus opportunities for gap years and apprenticeships, reminding students of all of these opportunities.
