- **Develop advanced coaching expertise:** Build your effectiveness as a coach by learning how to identify and work through a coachee's limiting beliefs and deliver powerful feedback that moves thinking and practice forward.
- **Master coaching models:** Confidently apply a range of formal and informal coaching models to support impactful, high-quality coaching conversations.
- **Lead impactful coaching at scale:** Learn how to lead effective coaching across groups and teams, delivering clear value and confidently measuring impact.
